NOTICE OF PUBLICATION OF PROPOSED AMENDMENTS RESPECTING DARK ORDER PRICE IMPROVEMENT OBLIGATIONS WHEN TRADING AGAINST AN ODD-LOT ORDER

IIROC is publishing for public comment proposed amendments to the Universal Market Integrity Rules. The proposed amendments would clarify a Dark Order's obligations respecting the requirement to provide a "better price" when executing against orders for less than one standard trading unit. The proposed amendments would confirm that the provision of price improvement by a Dark Order is not required if the order that it executes against is for less than one standard trading unit.
