I do not wish to have government policy ultimately decide where and how I should invest my money, and I do not agree with having my rights limited by a regulator. I believe, as an investor, it is my right to choose where and how much I want to invest. It is a highly personal decision based not only on my income and net worth, but also my risk tolerance, goals and preferences.

I, like some other investors, do not look at the illiquidity in the exempt market investments as a 'risk' and actually prefer having some of my assets sheltered from fluctuations of the public markets. I am aware of the risks and opportunities of investing in the exempt market and believe the existing rules are adequate.
