I am not too happy about the proposed contribution limits. They would limit my ability to invest in Canadian companies that require funding in order to expand their business. They would also prevent me from being able to grow my money in a more substantial way than would otherwise be possible.

Furthermore, I agree with the following statements:

- The freedom to invest in the exempt market should not be limited to the very rich, with everyone else having a small annual contribution limit.
- Building an investment portfolio is an individualized process and I should not have my choices and options limited based on "boxed" annual contribution room limits because of the bad past experienced by a small percentage of the investing population who chose not to diversify.

Please reconsider the proposed ammendments. We live in a land of freedom of choice and my choice to invest with a private company, with the amount of funds of my choice should remain my individual freedom.
